



## Welcome Back

This year at the Roberts School we will not see near as many changes as we have seen over the last couple years. We have only one new face currently on the teaching staff, we don't have any major changes to the schedule, and after a couple years of some major projects to the grounds, this summer has been basically upkeep to the facility. These upstairs classrooms have been completely remodeled and will hopefully help create a more comfortable learning environment for our students, especially since they will include air conditioning. Over the 2018 summer we hope to finish the entire upstairs including flooring. We continuously push to keep the facilities and grounds in best condition we can fiscally maintain. ## Staffing Updates

All of the 2016-2017 staff returns in similar capacity except for our high school & junior high mathematics teacher. Our new math teacher, Mrs. JoEllen Brennan comes to us most recently from teaching in Nampa, Idaho. She will bring an added veteran presence to our high school and junior staff. Look for her personal introduction later in the newsletter. A few other changes are Mr. Brian Frank will be teaching 2<sup>nd</sup> grade English Language Arts and Mathematics, & Mrs. Sheila Roberts will be teaching 1<sup>st</sup> grade English Language Arts and Mathematics. This allows us to separate the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade group in the mornings and give more direct instruction to each student. A final change is Peter Wisniewski, formally a paraprofessional and Erin Koch, formally a custodian, will be changing roles as Mr. Pete moves into a Director of Maintenance position and Miss Koch moves into a paraprofessional role.

## Year of Growth

As mentioned earlier, the last few years have had a feel of change, new teachers, new schedules, new calendars, new coaches, and not too long ago a new administrator. This year we will be focusing on a year of growth. Almost all of our staff returns in a role that they have previously filled or will have a chance to work with a staff member who has previously filled the role. This will allow our staff to focus on improving their craft, versus focusing on learning their duties. In turn, this will positively affect our students ability to grow academically. As a staff we are also excited to have committed one Friday a month to work on curriculum, positive behavior intervention systems, and other needs that can develop and strengthen our teaching team. Again this should greatly affect the growth of the students of Roberts's.

## Thank You

I did want to take a moment to say thank you to the many people of Roberts, community members, parents, staff and students I have met over the last three years. Many of you have been patient as we have changed numerous items to grow this into the school we all know it can and should be. If we continue to build on the foundation that has been laid, keep working hard, and keep caring about the needs of our students. We will continue to grow and get to that point once again.


