Student Happenings

We are once again off to a roaring start. First, our girls' cross country team, which sits ranked first in Class "C" with about a month to run as they look to repeat as state champions. The State meet is on Saturday, October 16th, in Missoula. Our boy's team has three participants who continue to improve and hope to make noise at the state meet.

Volleyball is again having a solid fall as the Lady Rockets currently sit in the 3rd District, with tournaments only a few weeks away. District Volleyball this year will be in Bridger from October 31st to November 2nd. Finally, the football co-op in Red Lodge is also off to a 4-1 start, following up from a great fall last year that eventually ended in a loss in the state semifinals.

Our Elementary students have begun their Friday programs. Last week, approximately 40 students went bowling in Billings. On October 25th, we have a group of kids signed up to go to the pumpkin patch in Clark, Wyoming. Then, on November 1st, we will take students ice skating.

Updated Math Curriculum K-8

Our students are utilizing a new math curriculum purchased with grant funds. The updated math curriculum, Eureka Math 2, has been well received by staff and students. Next Steps

The district made significant cost-saving steps from last school year to this school. Sadly, almost three complete teacher positions were cut, and we were no longer able to support our preschool programming. This has led to multiple combination classrooms in the elementary school and a significant change to our elementary library offerings. While these decisions were hard, we felt we took feedback from community meetings last fall with the failure of levy and prioritized increasing teacher and support staff salaries while increasing class sizes.

We have not made any decisions at the board level as to run a levy again next spring, but an ask again will be likely. Information on amounts will take longer to get out this year as we are in a new legislative biennium. As you can imagine, many bills are already being discussed for the hopper that addresses school funding in different ways. So, potentially, we may have more direct state support for our school in the upcoming years. If you have any questions or want to communicate with local legislators on some of these bills, please contact the school for more information.
